

# Millikan Student Support and Interventions

## Academic Support

*Millikan is proactive in identifying and supporting students who are struggling academically.*

- *Teacher Tutorial Schedules-* teachers post and communicate to students and parents available time for one-on-one tutoring.
- *After School Tutoring in Library-* credentialed teachers, college aides and qualified high school students are available for tutoring in a variety of subjects.
- *Extended Library Hours*
- *SLC Based Tutorials-* Several small learning communities offer tutoring directed towards the needs of the students in their academy, including QUEST, PEACE, COMPASS, STELLAR and GREEN.
- *CAHSEE Prep Classes and Review Sessions*
- *CAHSEE One-on-one tutoring*

- *School Loop-* Parents, Students and teachers share information in real time regarding student academic progress.
- *Report Card and Parent Conferences Day* – Twice a year, parents can come to Millikan on a Saturday to pick up report cards and conduct conferences with teachers.

## **College and Career Counseling**

*Millikan provides vision and support for students in the determination of their futures.*

- ❖ *Annual College and Career Fair*
- ❖ *College-Career Representatives at Millikan-* over 200 presentations by college, trade, technical and vocational representatives per year.
- ❖ *Career Center College Workshops and Presentations-* students are assisted with the process of college selection, application and financial aid. University and College representatives regularly present to Millikan students in the College and Career center.
- ❖ *College Guidance-* One on one assistance with college requirements, applications, and financial aid
- ❖ *Career Exploration-* Students are connected to internships, career resource library, and interests inventory tests
- ❖ *Employment Guidance-* Students are provided training in creating resumes, completing applications, obtaining work permits and interviewing skills.
