- ❖ Thank you to members of the Hope Club who are volunteering at the Rescue Mission doing food prep for the shelter residents

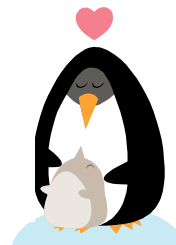
