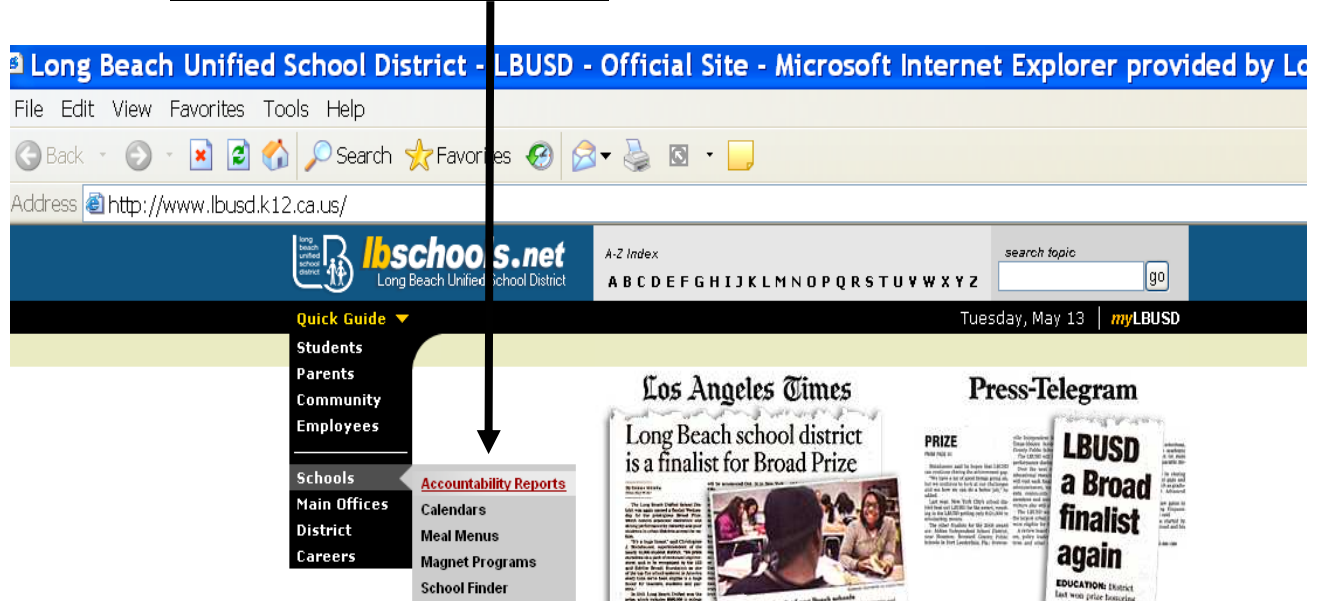
Dear Parents:

State law requires all public schools to create a **School Accountability Report Card (SARC)**. The purpose of the report card is to provide parents and the community with important information about your child's school, which includes:

- ✓ School Description and Mission
- ✓ School Programs and Instructional Materials
- ✓ Opportunities for Parent Involvement
- ✓ Test Results
- ✓ Safety Plan
- ✓ Facilities

We invite you to view the **School Accountability Report Card (SARC)** for your child's school. You can find a copy on the internet by following the steps below:

1. From your computer, go to the internet using your web browser
2. Type in the address for the LBUSD home page www.lbschools.net
3. Roll over the **QUICK GUIDE** directly below the LBUSD logo
4. Roll over **SCHOOLS**
5. Click **ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS**



6. Once the new page appears, select the school of interest from drop down menu. Click **GO**.
7. The SARC will open in Adobe Acrobat®. If you do not have Adobe, it is a free download.

If you do not wish to use a computer, you may pick up the **School Accountability Report Card** at your child's school. Feel free to stop in the office of any school in which you have an interest and ask for a copy.
